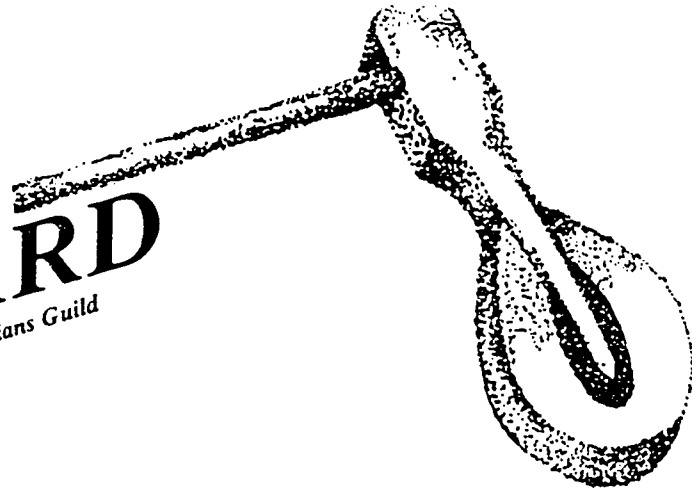

## Coming Events

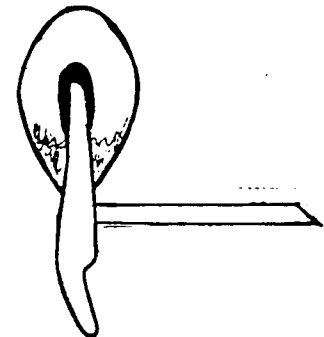

Replacing Steinway Hammers - When ordering new hammers for Steinway grands there are 2 bore sizes. Factory bore or standard. Factory bored hammers have a larger hole and are more suitable when being installed on new shanks. Standard bore have a smaller hole and are more acceptable for the old shanks.

After installation, all new Steinway hammers should be filed to give them a pointed or tapered shape (similar to that of an egg shape.)

This procedure really helps make the tone of the piano and should never be overlooked.
