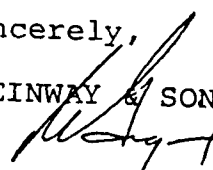
A general outline of the Seminar is enclosed for your perusal. As a great deal of the training involves actual bench work, it will be necessary for you to come equipped with the following tools:
